Independent Evaluation Report on SWISH Technology by Tolly Group

Matrixview announces the release of the independent evaluation report of its SWISH Technology. This independent evaluation was carried out by 'The Tolly Group' based in the United States. The evaluation covered the impact of SWISH on delivering search pages of 5 major search companies such as Google, Microsoft, Yahoo, AOL and ASK.

The following are the key highlights from the independent evaluation report:

- 1) Delivers search engine-generated HTML pages 11X and 2X faster over simulated 64 Kbps WAN links compared to "No Compression" and GZIP, respectively
- 2) Compresses 1,016 Google-generated HTML files (20MB) to 2.4MB averaging 4.5 ms/file; GZIP compresses to 5.8MB averaging 11.1ms/file
- 3) Outperforms GZIP in terms of download time and bandwidth usage for five popular search engines and for all WAN bandwidth scenarios tested up to 4 Mbps
